<p>Antoni Gaudi Antoni Gaudi was a Catalan architect.</p>	<p>Parc Guell Parc Güell is a park system composed of gardens and architectural elements located on Carmel Hill, in Barcelona, Catalonia, Spain.</p>
<p>Mosaic Pictures and patterns made from tiny pieces of coloured stone.</p>	<p>Border A strip forming the outer edge of something.</p>
<p>Motif A decorative image or design, especially a repeated one forming a pattern.</p>	<p>Tesserae Tiny stones of tiles used to make a mosaic.</p>
<p>Interstices The gaps in-between mosaic tiles.</p>	<p>Vibrant Colours that are bright and loud.</p>
<p>Knead Preparing clay for shaping by pushing and rolling it under the palm of your hand.</p>	<p>Wedge To knead the clay of push it repeatedly to help remove the air bubbles</p>
<p>Slip Wet clay that is used as glue.</p>	<p>Slab A flat piece of clay.</p>
