<p>Aesthetic How an object or product looks.</p>	<p>Air resistance The level of drag on an object as it is forced through the air.</p>
<p>Chassis The body of car.</p>	<p>Design To make, draw or write plans for something.</p>
<p>Design criteria A set of rules to help designers focus their ideas and test the success of them.</p>	<p>Function The purpose of an object (for example a chair needs to hold a person when sitting down) or how the product works.</p>
<p>Graphics Images which are designed to explain or advertise something.</p>	<p>Kinetic energy The energy that causes an object to move.</p>
<p>Mechanism The parts of an object that move together as part of a machine.</p>	<p>Net A flat 2D shape, that can become a 3D shape once assembled.</p>
<p>Structure Something that has been made and put together and can usually stand on its own (E.g a building, a bridge, a chair).</p>
