Physical feature - A feature that has been formed by nature.	Human feature - A feature that has been made or changed by humans. E.g., bridges.	Map symbol - A picture or a sign on a map that represents something else.	Key - Helps us understand map symbols.
Compass - A tool which shows people which direction they are travelling in and helps them find their way.	London – The capital city of England.	Capital City – The city where the country’s government is located.	Landmark – An object or feature which is easily recognised from a distance and helps to establish a location.
