<p>Community A group of people with something in common.</p>	<p>Prayer Prayer is the activity of speaking to God.</p>
<p>Christian A person who believes in Christ.</p>	<p>Muslim A person who follows the religion of Islam.</p>
<p>Jews A person who follows Judaism.</p>	<p>Religious ceremonies A special occasion that celebrates a special event.</p>

Christian Symbols

Some people are Christians. The cross is a symbol of Christianity. There are other symbols too: a candle, the Bible.

Jewish Symbols

Some people are Jewish. The Star of David is a symbol of Judaism. They also have a menorah candle holder and the Torah.

Muslim Symbols

Some people are Muslims. The crescent moon with a star is a symbol of Islam.
