<p>Media content Photos, videos or messages</p>
<p>Offline Not being connected to the internet.</p>
<p>Online Being connected to the internet via a device such as a computer, laptop or phone.</p>
<p>Passwords A word or set of numbers we use the access to our personal information online. It helps to keep our online information safe.</p>
<p>Personal information Information such as our full name, address, birthday or where we go to school.</p>
